Year 7	<p><b><i>The Story of the Bible (4A1)</i></b></p> <p>An introduction to the structure of the Bible and how it tells one big story of a promise-keeping God.</p>	<p><b><i>The Big story of the Old Testament (4B1)</i></b></p> <p>An overview of Genesis, addressing why God made the world, what went wrong and how God will make all things right.</p>	<p><b><i>Who is Jesus? (4A2 &amp; 4B2)</i></b></p> <p>Students reflect upon their first impressions of Jesus through a guided inquiry unit addressing the life and times, teaching and miracles of Jesus.</p>	<p><b><i>Jesus Through the Eyes of Women</i></b></p> <p>A series looking at Jesus through the eyes of first century women in the New Testament.</p>
Year 8	<p><b><i>A story of Deliverance (5A1)</i></b></p> <p>An overview of Exodus, tracing the theme of deliverance.</p>	<p><b><i>Jesus 'I Am' claims (5B2)</i></b></p> <p>Three lessons in John's gospel, studying Jesus' 'I Am' claims and people's responses.</p>	<p><b><i>Big questions (4A4)</i></b></p> <p>This unit addresses some of the big questions people have about life, faith and Christianity.</p>	<p><b><i>Meals that Jesus Had (5A3)</i></b></p> <p>A series of different meals Jesus shared with people in Luke's gospel and what they reveal about Jesus' identity.</p>
Year 9	<p><b><i>Personal Convictions (5B4)</i></b></p> <p>Three lessons examining what a life of conviction looks like as students consider Bible figures like Daniel.</p>	<p><b><i>Spiritual convictions (4A4)</i></b></p> <p>An introduction to different worldviews of major religions.</p>	<p><b><i>Changing Convictions (Bible Explored)</i></b></p> <p>A film study of 'The Case for Christ' analysing the historical evidence supporting the claims of Christianity.</p>	<p><b><i>Strong Convictions (Jesus the Game Changer)</i></b></p> <p>This unit explores a range of contemporary issues from a variety of worldviews, including a Christian one.</p>
Year 10		<p><b><i>Understanding and Living in the World (5B4)</i></b></p> <p>Students consider what Jesus teaches about achievement and security and examine their own attitudes and values in response.</p>
